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1. QUALITATIVE INFORMATION ON OPERATING RESULTS AND FINANCIAL POSITION

(1) Explanation on Operating Results

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter (from April 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015), the Group recorded operating revenue of ¥85,284 million (8.1% increase from the same period of the previous fiscal year (i.e. year-on-year)) due to factors such as year-on-year increases in cash equity trading value and derivatives trading volume, while operating expenses were ¥36,103 million (9.4% year-on-year decrease). As a result, the Group recorded operating income of ¥51,745 million (28.9% year-on-year increase) and income before income tax of ¥52,971 million (28.4% year-on-year increase).

In addition, net income attributable to owners of the parent company after tax was ¥35,504 million (32.6% year-on-year increase).

1) Trading services revenue

Trading services revenue comprises "Transaction Fees" based on the value of securities traded or volume of derivatives traded, "Basic Fees" based on the types of the trading participant's trading qualification, "Access Fees" based on the number of orders, and "Trading System Facilities Usage Fees" based on the types of trading system facilities used.

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, trading services revenue increased 7.3% year-on-year to ¥38,774 million due to increases in trading of cash equities and derivatives.

2) Clearing services revenue

Clearing services revenue comprises clearing fees related to the assumption of obligations of financial instrument transactions carried out by Japan Securities Clearing Corporation.

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, clearing services revenue increased 14.9% year-on-year to ¥17,158 million due to increases in trading of cash equity and derivatives, which are the main clearing product segments.

3) Listing services revenue

Listing services revenue comprises "Initial/Additional Listing Fees" that are received based on the issue amount when a company initially lists or when a listed company issues additional shares, and "Annual Listing Fees" received from listed companies based on their market capitalization.

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, listing services revenue increased 9.2% year-on-year to ¥10,051 million.

4) Information services revenue

Information services revenue comprises revenue related to the provision of market information to information vendors, etc. (market information fees), revenue related to the index business, and revenue related to the provision of corporate action information and other information.

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, information services revenue increased 9.9% year-on-year to ¥13,192 million due mainly to an increase in market information fees and an increase in index business revenue.

5) Other operating revenue

Other operating revenue includes the following main items:

- Usage fees for arrownet, which connects trading, market information and other systems to trading participants and other users;
- Usage fees related to co-location services that allow trading participants, information vendors, and other users to install devices in the system center for the purpose of improving trade execution efficiency by shortening order transmission time, etc.; and
- Revenue from system development and operations conducted by consolidated subsidiary TOSHO SYSTEM SERVICE CO., LTD.

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, other operating revenue decreased 7.9% year-on-year to ¥6,107 million due mainly to a decrease in revenue from system development and operations.

(Operating expenses)

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, personnel expenses increased 3.1% year-on-year to ¥11,378 million.

System maintenance and operation expenses include expenses related to maintenance and management/operations of various systems including the cash equities and derivatives trading systems. During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, system maintenance and operation expenses decreased 5.6% year-on-year to ¥7,077 million due mainly to the integration of clearing systems and networks integration.

Depreciation and amortization decreased 23.8% year-on-year to ¥6,733 million due mainly to the end of the 5-year period for depreciation and amortization of the initial investment in the arrowhead cash equities trading system in the previous fiscal year.

During the consolidated cumulative third quarter, other operating expenses decreased 12.5% year-on-year to ¥10,914 million due mainly to lower rent for the Tokyo Stock Exchange building.

(2) Explanation on Financial Position

(Assets, liabilities and equity)

For assets and liabilities of the Group, "clearing business financial assets and liabilities" assumed by Japan Securities Clearing Corporation as a clearing organization and "deposits from clearing participants" deposited by clearing participants as collateral are included under both assets and liabilities. "Clearing business financial assets and liabilities" and "deposits from clearing participants" have a large impact on the amount of assets and liabilities of the Group due to their sizable amounts and daily fluctuations subject to changes in clearing participants' positions. In addition, "legal guarantee funds," "trading participant security money," and "default compensation reserve funds" based on the rules for securing safety of financial instruments transactions are included under assets and liabilities or equity.

Total assets as of December 31, 2015 decreased ¥2,715,910 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥25,030,860 million as a result of decreases in clearing business financial assets. Excluding clearing business financial assets, deposits from clearing participants, legal guarantee funds, and default compensation reserve funds, assets increased ¥8,372 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥296,522 million.

Total liabilities as of December 31, 2015 decreased ¥2,729,322 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥24,775,884 million as a result of decreases in clearing business financial liabilities. Excluding clearing business financial liabilities, deposits from clearing participants, legal guarantee funds, and trading participant security money, liabilities decreased ¥5,032 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥62,062 million. Total equity as of December 31, 2015 increased ¥13,411 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥254,976 million due mainly to an increase in retained earnings in connection with recording of net income attributable to owners of the parent company. In addition, after excluding default compensation reserve funds,

There are no revisions to the consolidated earnings forecast from the forecast figures announced in the "Notice of Revision to Earnings Forecast and Dividend Forecast" on September 24, 2015 (hereinafter "previously disclosed material").

The consolidated earnings forecast for the year ending March 31, 2016 is based on the assumptions that the average daily trading values and volumes are ¥3.0 trillion for stocks*, 39,000 contracts for 10-year JGB futures transactions, 100,000 contracts for TOPIX futures transactions, 223,000 contracts for Nikkei 225 futures transactions (including mini contract trading volume converted to large-sized contracts), and ¥27.0 billion for Nikkei 225 options transactions (excluding Weekly Options).

(ii) Dividends Forecast

There are no revisions to the dividend forecast from the forecast figures announced in previously disclosed material.

The Company adopts a dividend policy with a target payout ratio of about 60% tied to business performance while giving due consideration to the importance of internal reserves for the following purposes:

- Maintaining sound financial health as a financial instruments exchange group,
- Preparing for risks as a clearing organization, and
- Enabling the group to pursue investment opportunities to raise the competitiveness of its markets as they
 arise.

2. OTHER INFORMATION

(1) Changes in accounting policies / Changes in accounting estimates (Changes in accounting estimates)

In the consolidated third quarter accounting period, Osaka Exchange, Inc. has reviewed the useful lives of property and equipment, and intangible assets that are shortened from the initial estimates due to the decision to launch new IT systems.

The effect of this change in estimates was to decrease operating income and income before income tax each by ¥292 million.
